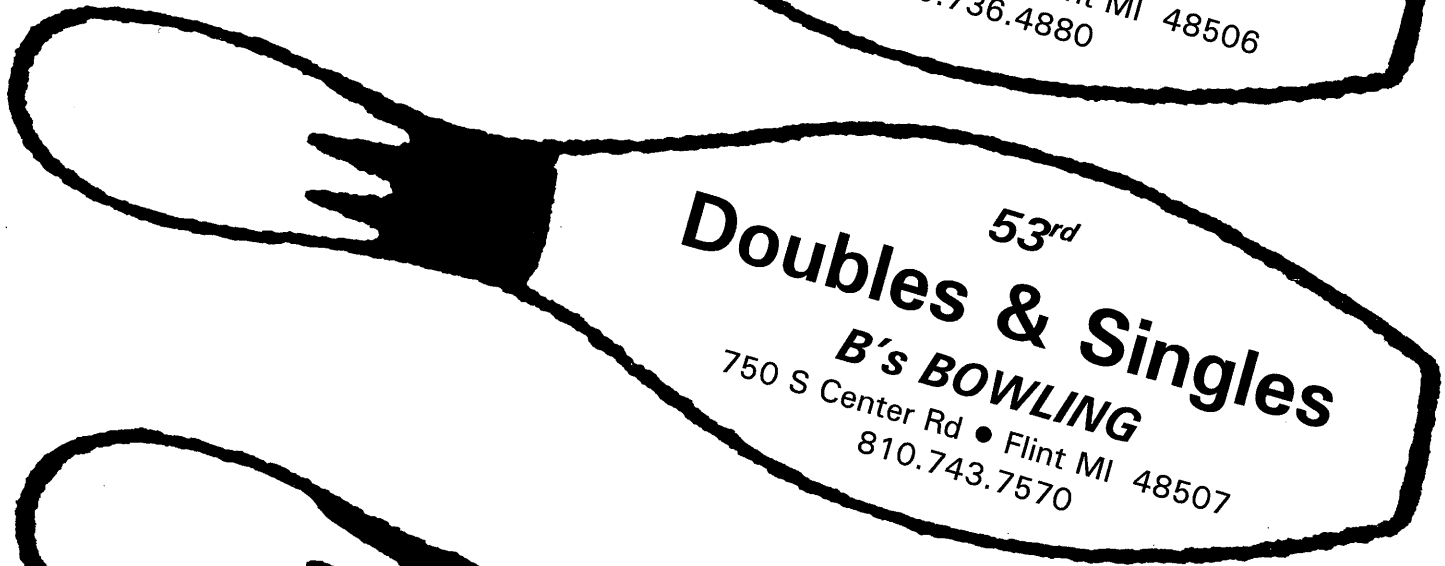
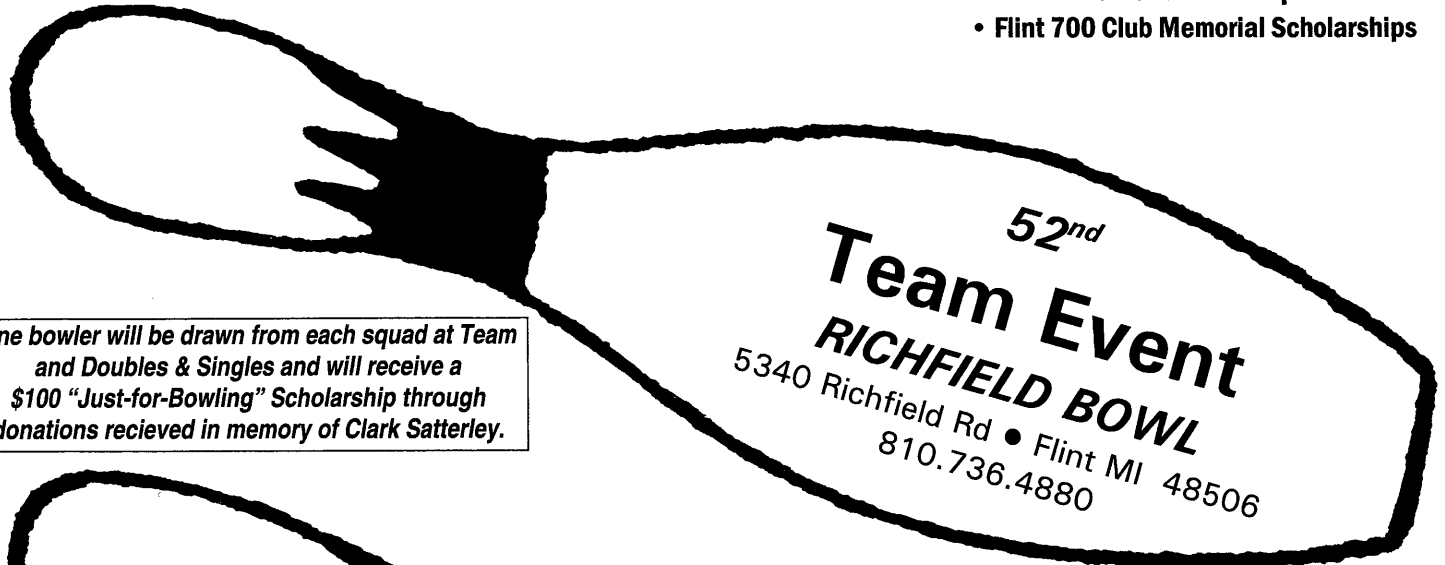

## PLEASE READ THESE TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament. All participants must be from a league in a center in USBC's jurisdiction for the Greater Flint USBC Youth Association.
2. Handicap will be 90% from 230 scratch for all divisions except where divisions are listed as OPEN.
3. If league session qualifications are met, tournament average will be determined by the following (*bowlers from all high school leagues will use January 31 instead of December 31*): NOTE: All current league averages are verified. If a bowler does not have the necessary games as of Dec. 31, 2016, a second sheet MUST be submitted as soon as games are met.
  - 1.) Greater Flint USBC Youth highest 2015-16 average, 15 or more games, from previous season, winter or summer, unless –
    - a.) average as of Dec. 31, 2016, (minimum 5 league sessions needed with a minimum of 10 games) is 15 or more pins above their highest 2015-16 average or as of the 15 games (whichever comes last), or
    - b.) they do not have 5 league sessions, minimum 10 games by Dec. 31, 2016, then the average after completing the fifth league session (minimum 10 games) will be used if 15 or more pins above highest yearbook average.
  - 2.) Bowlers with no previous season Greater Flint USBC Youth average will use their highest Greater Flint average as of Dec. 31, 2016, with a minimum of 5 league sessions (minimum 10 games), or must have bowled at least 5 league sessions (minimum 10 games) by the scheduled date of the Tournament.
  - 3.) If bowler only has a sport, or comparable league average, adjustment will be made using the USBC Sport Average Adjustment Scale. One (1) league sheet from the first bowling day in January (February for all high school leagues) must be submitted from every youth league in the Greater Flint area. If any bowler does not have five (5) league sessions (minimum 10 games) by Dec. 31, 2016, (Jan. 31, 2017, for high school leagues) a second average sheet must be submitted. *Please include league name, date scores are results of, and coach's name and phone number on all Standings Sheets.*
5. Any falsification of averages will result in disqualification of bowlers.
6. All entries received by **Thursday, January 26, 2017**, will appear on coach's full schedule and will be posted on-line for viewing. Final entries will be accepted through **Monday, February 13, 2017**, where needed to fill squads with openings.
7. The Tournament will be divided into average classes as listed on each entry. *There are scholarship opportunities in Singles, Doubles and All Events as well as the High School Division in Team.*

*Team Event:* four girls, four boys, or any combination of four bowlers. Bowlers may compete as many times as they wish in Team with a change of at least two bowlers. The first appearance in Team event shall count for All Events score and for Scholarship score.

*Doubles & Singles:* two girls or two boys only (no mixed doubles). Bowlers may compete only once in Doubles & Singles. If bowl doubles, must also bowl singles.

*Optional All Events:* All Events is the combined total scores rolled in Team, Doubles and Singles. Average class in Singles shall determine the All Events class. All Classifications will bowl three (3) games in each of the events: Team; Doubles; and Singles and will have a nine (9) game total for All Events. The \$2.00 optional All Events fee = \$1.25 awards and .75 for banquet/expense.

*Optional High School Team Division:* The team must consist of bowlers in grades 9-12, can be from ANY high school and do not have to have bowled on a high school team. Team is competing for scholarship points only, no All City Points or other awards. The \$5 optional fee must be paid by each bowler on the team and 100% will go towards scholarship points for the 1<sup>st</sup> Place team in this division.
8. Bowlers MUST check in 45 minutes before start of their scheduled squad. Substitutions should be made at least one hour before squad.
9. Competitors arriving late shall begin competition with the frame in progress. Frames missed or competitors not present to bowl when it is their turn will receive zero for that frame. Teams arriving late will be permitted to bowl at the discretion of the Tournament Officials. If a doubles partner arrives late, the partner that is present will start their Singles event first, and then bowl their Doubles.
10. Bowlers must bowl in order listed on entry. Substitutes will be permitted only in the same lineup position. Once a substitute has been put into play, the regular cannot enter the lineup, unless an emergency arises, at which time the Tournament Officials will rule.
11. Full fees for each bowler for each event must accompany the entry including the optional AE and HS Team. No refunds will be issued.
12. Please dress appropriately as a dress code will be in effect. If a bowler wears the following, they must change or will not be allowed to bowl. NO hats, NO short skirts or skorts (knee length), NO shirts advertising drinking and/or smoking. NO shirts with any sort of suggestive material printed on them and NO midriff shirts. Exposed midriffs and exposed undergarments will not be allowed. *All electronic device usage will stop 15 minutes before the squad time until all bowlers that squad have finished their competition.*
13. Award fund is returned 100% and will be given according to the number of entries in each class on a ratio of one in eight entries. First place is guaranteed. Champions from leagues processed through Gr Flint Youth will be guests at the Greater Flint Youth Annual Awards Banquet in June. Only tournament standings awards are available to those bowlers whose membership is not processed through Gr Flint.
14. Awards earned may also include a scholarship opportunity with amounts to be determined following graduation from high school when required scholastic criteria is received and reviewed. Qualified applicants must submit the scholarship application along with a copy of their high school transcript and proof of acceptance to the accredited institution of their choice and have met the minimum academic requirements for admission. Scholarship opportunities by grades will be awarded to the bowlers that bowl the most pins over their tournament average after competing in all three events (team, doubles, singles). Divisions, determined by the bowler's grade, are: 5<sup>th</sup> grade & under, 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grade; and 9<sup>th</sup> grade & over. Each scholarship division will award a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and if enough entries (46) a 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Special scholarships can be earned by bowling the most pins over the tournament average after competing in all three events. *Graduating Senior* (must graduate in 2017); *Phil Pierson* (boy with 175+ average); *Fred Krawiec Memorial* (girl with 150+ average); *700 Club Memorial Scholarship* (Bowlers in 9<sup>th</sup> grade & above are divided into two groups, the top ½ averages and bottom ½ averages. The top bowler in each of the divisions will be eligible for a scholarship) and the *Al Teuber First Time Tournament Bowler* (a scholarship is awarded per grade division if three entries in that division. If a division does not have 3 entries, no scholarship will be awarded for that division.) Bowlers can earn all scholarships eligible for. Scholarships awarded by Greater Flint USBC Youth may be applied for, following graduation from high school, on a Greater Flint USBC Scholarship Payment Request Form. At no time may scholarships be disbursed prior to high school graduation. In order to redeem scholarships, applicants must meet MHSAA regulations and Greater Flint USBC Youth Association guidelines.
15. **No coaching will be permitted** during the Tournaments. Only bowlers, monitors/scorekeepers, and Tournament Officials are allowed in the bowling area. Smoking / drinking of alcoholic beverages by adults will be permitted in designated areas only. None by participants.
16. Any exceptions of Tournament Rules listed will be resolved at the discretion of Tournament Officials. Any appeal or protest regarding scores shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager within 24 hours. Any protest regarding eligibility shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager before the distribution of the awards is made.
